Her Ballet instruction included classes at York University's Dance programme as well as with the Diana Vorps School of Ballet and Les Ballet Jazz de Montreal. Morghynn Karenn has performance experience in dance, theatre, musical theatre and commercials appearing on television, stage, and screen. She comes from a family of performance artists, singers, musicians and actors.

Ms. Karenn also attended law school at Osgoode Hall in Toronto where she graduated to practice law in 1983. She relates that she had the unique experience at that time of being the first person to present a dance section at the law school's annual variety show known as "the Mock Trial".
