



Trained as a classical violinist, Toronto musician **Alex Cheung** continues his journey through many different musical styles and genres. He has had the opportunity to perform Folk, Celtic, Pop/Rock, Country, Jazz, R&B, and Classical music. He is a certified Suzuki Violin Method Teacher and a member of Suzuki Association of the Americas. He is a member of several GTA based-bands including: *the McFlies*, an acoustic 80's band with a twist; *the Parkdale Revolutionary Orchestra*, where classical meets art rock; and Celtic band *Up All Night*.
